RE: More super star Republicans running for state house -- let's send Speaker Frank Chopp packing

The state house is currently 50 Democrats, 48 Republicans. So a 2+ seat gain for the GOP in November means Seattle-liberal Frank Chopp loses his speakership and is sent packing.

On Tuesday, we highlighted 4 super star GOP candidates. Here are several more and they all strongly support letting the voters decide on a 2/3-For-Taxes Constitutional Amendment:

* 47TH DISTRICT (Kent, etc): Republican Barry Knowles came darn close to taking out anti-2/3 mega-liberal Democrat Pat Sullivan in 2014 and he's working super hard in this rematch (<http://barryknowles.com/>). Even though 70% of voters in this conservative district support the 2/3, Democrat Sullivan specifically voted against letting the people vote on a 2/3-for-taxes constitutional amendment this session. What arrogance! If you care about taxes, you just gotta support Republican Knowles and oppose Democrat Sullivan in the 47th.

* 5th DISTRICT (Issaquah, etc): Republican Paul Graves is running for this open seat in 5th district where 68% of voters support the 2/3. So his strong support for letting the voters vote on the 2/3-for-taxes constitutional amendment really helps him in this race (www.paulgraveswa.com). Two crazy tax-hiking liberal Democrats are battling it out to face him and both oppose letting the people vote on making it tougher to raise taxes. If you care about taxes, you just gotta support Republican Graves in the 5th.

* 19TH DISTRICT (Longview, etc): A whopping 70% of voters from this district support the 2/3, but super-arrogant mega-liberal Democrat JD Rossetti specifically voted against letting the people vote on a 2/3-for-taxes constitutional amendment. Republicans Jim Walsh (<https://www.electjimwalsh.org/>) and Val Tinney (<http://www.electvaltinney.com/>) both respect the voters and wanna give them the opportunity to vote on the 2/3-for-taxes constitutional amendment.
