On the first official day of the session, the 25 members of the MCC installed a 2/3-for-any-tax-increase vote requirement in the formal rules. **That protection will only stay in effect as long as the MCC controls the senate.** If the Democrats ever take over, they'll repeal it immediately and kate bar the door 'cause they'll then impose massive tax increases, especially an income tax -- it's an absolute certainty.

So the 2/3 rule is a tenuous protection, but it's still one worthy of our recognition and appreciation.
